



REPORT ON THE ACTIVITY HELD TO COMMEMORATE 75 YEARS OF THE ADOPTION OF CONSTITUTION OF INDIA ON 26TH NOVEMBER 2024

As per the circular received from The Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra regarding the reading of the preamble of the Constitution of India on November 26th 2024 in the "Amrit Mahotsav Year" of the Constitution to increase its awareness as well as the constitutional rights and duties among students, a presentation to students was held detailing the formation of the constitution, its architect, framing, history, philosophy, its preamble, parts, articles, amendments, schedules and appendices.
